



Attire Guidelines: Middle School Programs

BUSINESS CASUAL

To be worn every day for half the day.

Business Casual is worn during lectures, leadership sessions and academic activities. We recommend students plan for multiple outfits that can be made with the same basic pieces.

Pants, khakis, skirts, or dress shorts

- No blue denim or denim-type fabric.
- Skirts and shorts should be an appropriate length and style for a leadership conference.

Collared shirts, blouses, or button downs

- Shirts should be of appropriate style for a leadership program.
- Shirts should be tucked in.

Shoes

- No flip flops.
- You will have to walk distances in these shoes! We recommend shoes that you feel comfortable wearing. We also highly recommend breaking in new shoes before the program.

CASUAL

To be worn every day for half the day.

Casual attire is worn during tours, free time, and informal activities.

All casual attire should be respectful and professional, avoiding inappropriate images or language related to alcohol, drugs, or other unsuitable subjects.

- Tennis shoes and flip flops are acceptable for casual attire.
- Shirts, shorts and skirts must be an appropriate style.
- This is a professional conference and clothing should be reflective of the setting, even for casual attire.

Note: Outdoor activities may be planned. Please bring at least one outfit inc. closed-toe tennis shoes that you do not mind getting dirty.



Packing Checklist: Middle School Programs

TOILETRIES

- Shower/bathroom caddy
- Shower sandals
- Soap & shampoo
- Toothpaste & toothbrush
- Comb or brush
- Hairdryer
- Deodorant
- Sunscreen
- Towel (university provides 1 small towel)
- Hangers (optional, not provided)

SUPPLIES/MISC.

- Water Bottle (required)
- Light sweater or jacket for cooler buildings
- A copy of your medical insurance card (keep with you)
- Pens, pencils, highlighters
- Notebook
- Backpack
- Umbrella or Poncho (preferred)
- Clorox wipes (travel pack)

SPENDING MONEY

Students will eat off campus once or twice during field trips and typically like to visit the campus bookstore for souvenirs.

We recommend \$100-\$150 for a 6-day session on a prepaid credit or debit card. ATMs are available across campus.

PHOTO ID

Photo IDs can be required for certain field trips. Please bring a State ID, School ID, or Passport.

LINENS

What linens does the University provide?

1 set of Twin XL sheets, 1 blanket, 1 pillow, and 1 small towel

MASKS

Masks may be required for certain field trips. Please plan to have a mask with you at all times in case it becomes necessary.

LAPTOP

Laptops are highly recommended but not required for your workshops and presentations.

NSLC will not have laptops for students to check out. Students work in teams. Students without laptops will be paired with those that bring laptops to campus.

Suggestion: bring any adapters you may want to project your screen. Do not forget your charger.

DORM INFO

What furniture is in my dorm room?

1 bed, 1 set of drawers, 1 closet and 1 bookshelf

Can I do laundry?

You may put money on your university cards to pay for laundry. Only \$5, \$10 and \$20 bills are accepted to load money to your card. Machines are \$1.50 wash and \$1.50 dry.

DO NOT BRING
